**“to allow Tertiary Education Institutions
that are not Members of the company to
become Associates”**



By-law 2010-01

- (A) Tertiary Educational Institutions with data communications circuit connections to the Kentish MAN may apply to become Associates of Kent MAN Ltd.
- (B) Every Tertiary Educational Institution desirous of becoming an Associate of the Company must sign and deliver to the Company an application in the form following namely:

“To

I/We

desire to become an Associate of the Company and request you to enter my/our name in the Register of Associates accordingly. We agree to comply with the terms of the Memorandum and Articles of Association and any By-laws of the Company”.

- (C) This By-law will cease at 23:59 on 30th September 2011, unless amended by the Company beforehand.
- (D) Membership fees for Associates are determined according to the JISC banding of the Institution (see: http://www.jiscollections.ac.uk/jisc_banding.aspx), as follows:

Band	Fee
F	£1,000
G	£500
H	£350
I	£200
J	£100

- (E) Associate fees are due on application. The Institution will become an Associate when the appropriate fee has been paid in full.
- (F) An Associate will not have voting rights at any meetings of the Company.
- (G) An Associate may authorise one person to attend any Executive Committee meetings.
- (H) Two persons from among the Associates representatives may attend General Meetings as observers. Those two persons shall be elected by ballot from among the Associate representatives attending the Executive Committee meetings.
- (I) Associates may benefit from any special arrangements for services that may be made available to them from time to time by consent of the Board.
